

ORDINANCE NUMBER 456

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 384 AND ORDINANCE NO 454 WHICH PROHIBITS THE KEEPING OF HORSES, CATTLE, MULES, DONKEYS, SHEEP, GOATS AND SWINE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MOLINE, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MOLINE KANSAS.

SECTION ONE

That the keeping of horses, cattle, mules, donkeys, sheep, goats within the corporate limits of the City of Moline shall be permitted on the following described real estate, to-wit: East 26 ft. Lot 3, all of lots 4-8 & vacant street of Block 6, all of Block 5, East 1/2 of Lot 3 of Block 4, Block 42 Lots 8 and vacated alley, Block 46 Lots 1-11 and vacated alley, Block 47 Lots 1-3 and vacated street, all of Block 9 and vacated alley, Lot 8 and vacated alley, block 26 and all of Block 8 and a tract beginning 680 feet east of the Northwest corner Southwest Quarter, thence East 503 feet, thence South 150 feet, thence East 150 feet, thence South 15 feet, thence West 300 feet, thence South 300 feet, thence West 357 feet, thence North 518 feet to the place of beginning and the North 33 feet of vacated Fifth Street in Section 10, Township 31, Range 10 east Elk County Kansas all in the City of Moline

SECTION TWO

Ordinance Number 384 and Number 454 are hereby amended as to the real estate herein described and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in existence are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent with this ordinance.

SECTION THREE

This Ordinance shall take effect following its passage by the governing body of the City of Moline and its publication in the official city newspaper.
