

ORDINANCE NO. 464

AN ORDINANCE to permit the licenses for drinking establishments, Class A and Class B Clubs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MOLINE, KANSAS:

Section 1: License.

(a) Fees. There is hereby levied a license fee for each or licensed premises within the City of Moline which has the appropriate license issued by the State Director of Alcoholic Beverage Control, which license fee shall be paid before business is begun under an original state license and within five days after any renewal of a state license as follows:

- (1) License fee for each drinking establishment is \$250.00 biennially. (Can be up to \$500.00.)
- (2) License fee for each class A club is \$250.00 biennially (Can be up to \$500.00.)
- (3) License fee for each class B club is \$250.00 biennially. (Can be up to \$500.00.)

There is hereby levied a temporary event permit fee in the amount of \$25.00 per day for each person holding a temporary permit issued by the state director of alcoholic beverage control authorizing such sales within the City, which fee shall be paid before the event is begun pursuant to the state permit.

(b) Upon the exhibition to the City Clerk of a certified copy of the applicant's license from the State Director of Alcoholic Beverage Control and the payment of the fees set out in subsection (a), the City Clerk shall issue to the license holder a receipt showing that the occupation tax has been paid and the payment shall be the payment in full for the term of the license as shown by the certified copy of the license as presented to the City Clerk. The receipt shall show the expiration date of the license and shall recite that the occupation tax or license fee levied by the city has been paid

Section 2: No retailer shall sell any alcoholic liquor on premises which:

(a) Are located within 200 feet of any public or parochial school or church except that If any such school, or church shall be established within 200 feet of any licensed premises after such premises have been licensed then such premises shall be an eligible location for a license;

Section 3: No person shall sell at retail any alcoholic liquor on Memorial Day, Independence Day Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day and before 9:00 am or after 11:00 pm. on any day when sale is permitted.
